

**ST. ANNE'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL, BUXTON  
SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY 2013**

It is the policy of the Governors that school uniform should be worn. The uniform is as follows:-

**BOYS**

Long-sleeved White Shirt with  
button-up collar and cuffs  
School Tie  
School Pullover  
Dark Grey Trousers - **not** black  
  
Plain Grey or White Socks  
Black or Navy Outdoor shoes  
Indoor shoes

**GIRLS**

Long-sleeved White Blouse with  
button-up collar and cuffs  
School Tie  
School Cardigan/Pullover  
Dark Grey Skirt/Pinafore  
Dark Grey Trousers - straight legged/front zip  
Plain White socks or Grey or Navy Tights  
Black or Navy Outdoor shoes  
Indoor shoes - no heels

Please note that should a parent wish their child to wear trousers they must conform to the description specified above.

**JEANS ARE NOT PERMITTED**

P.E. wear should consist of a white T-shirt or polo shirt, navy blue shorts and trainers (for outdoor Games). Football strip is provided by the school for matches.

During the summer term, and up to the October half-term if the weather is warm, the girls may wear blue and white striped or checked dresses; boys may wear grey school shorts. Both boys and girls may wear white short-sleeved shirts and school tie

Hair-clips must be worn to hold back hair, and hair bands must be blue or white. Multi-coloured fashion accessories should be kept for home wear.

We would also ask parents/carers to consider the activities that take place in school and ensure that girls' skirts are a reasonable length!

Governors have been mindful of the expense that parents/carers experience when purchasing footwear for their child/ren but, in order to obtain some conformity in this area, we have decided that only plain black or navy shoes/trainers will be allowed as outdoor shoes. Parents/carers will still be expected to provide suitable indoor shoes or trainers. Please note that P.E. trainers may be used for both indoor shoes and outdoor games if you wish, as outdoor P.E. only takes place when the weather is fine. We would ask that parents/carers regularly check the condition of their children's footwear and replace them when they become too small or too worn for health and safety reasons. We must also insist that shoes with high heels or platforms are not worn, as they constitute a Health and Safety risk as the children move around the school premises.

A shoe-bag is provided by the School. All articles of clothing should be clearly marked with the owner's name. Reading Bags and P.E. bags are available and we recommend that they be purchased from the school

As part of the school uniform, and following recommendations by the Health Authority, parents/carers may purchase sun hats (either legionnaire caps or baseball caps) from the school.

Following Local Authority policy, the wearing of jewellery is forbidden in school for health and safety reasons. Rings, bracelets, necklaces, brooches, earrings, etc. are a source of potential danger to children in an active school life, especially during games and physical education. Should parents/carers wish their child to have their ears pierced, this should be done at the beginning of the summer holidays, so sleepers/studs can be removed at the start of the next term.

Pupils in Key Stage 2 may wear a plain analogue watch, i.e. non-digital, if they wish. However, it is not to be considered as a fashion accessory and must be for practical use only. It is the pupil's responsibility to keep it safe at all times.

Long hair should be tied back at all times, and long fringes fastened back, to help prevent the spread of headlice: this applies to both boys and girls. No child should come into school with an 'aggressive' haircut. This includes hair shaved to the minimum, lines shaved into the hair to make patterns, and dyed hair.

Governors have done their best to balance expense with the need to enforce a uniform policy that will be uniform for all the children. Governors expect the Headteacher to enforce this policy
