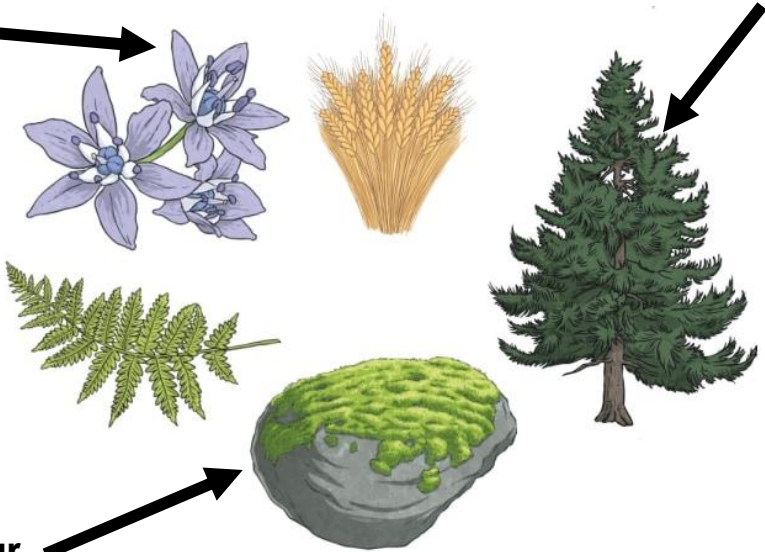


# Year 4

## Grouping Plants and Animals

**Vascular**  
Plants that have **vascular** vessels to transport water and food throughout the plant.

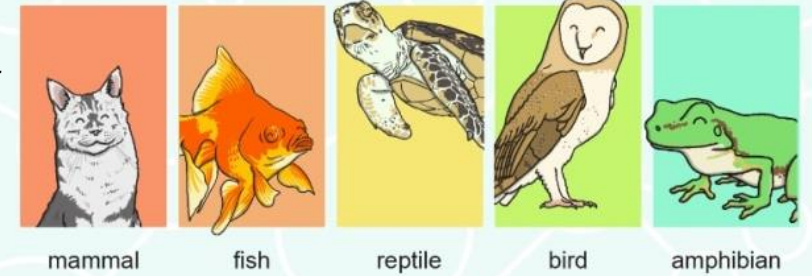


**Nonvascular**  
Plants are small, simple plants without a **vascular** system.

**Gymnosperms**  
Plants which produce seeds that are open to the air and are directly fertilized by pollination.

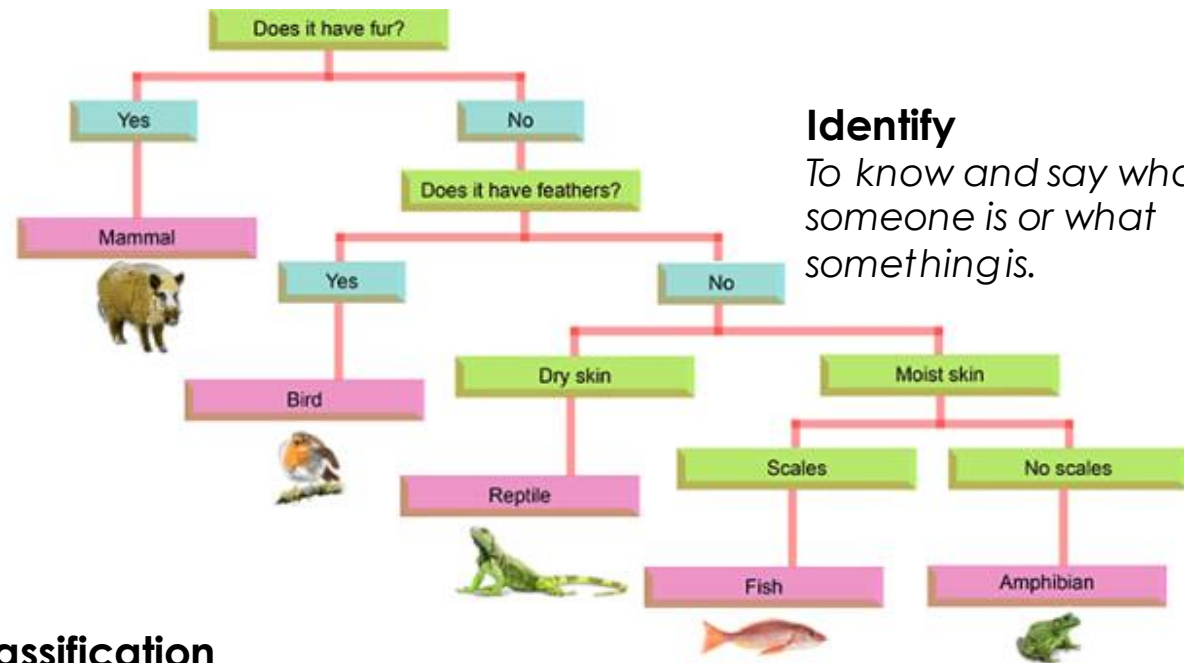


**Vertebrates**  
An animal with a backbone.  
Vertebrates can be organised into 5 groups:



**Invertebrates**  
An animal without a backbone.
